Many countries have already established their NETD; UK, Canada, Brazil, Taiwan, Turkey, Lithuania, South Africa, India, Iran, ...

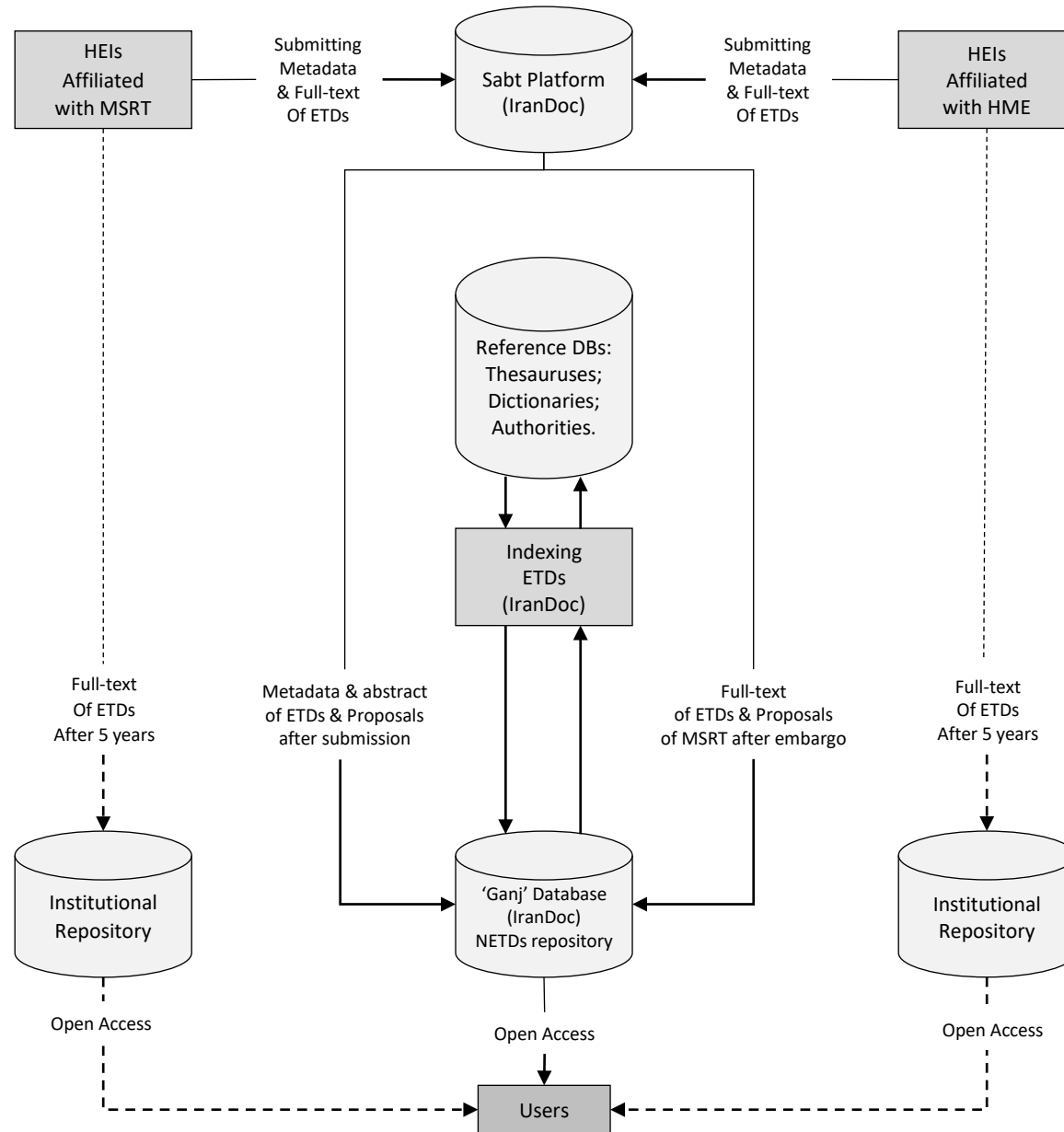

# Iranian NETD: A short history

- ❑ Collecting TDs started by IranDoc in 1969; *Bibliography of Theses in Social Science* has been printed in July 1974;
- ❑ The Minister of Culture and Higher Education in 1992 requested HEIs to submit the titles of the approved PhD dissertations to IranDoc;
- ❑ MSRT in 2005 and 2007 requested HEIs to submit an electronic/printed copy of these to IranDoc;
- ❑ A dedicated chapter within law in 2017 mandated all Iranian HEIs to submit their ETDs and proposals to IranDoc.
- ❑ IranDoc developed two main portals (SABT and GANJ).

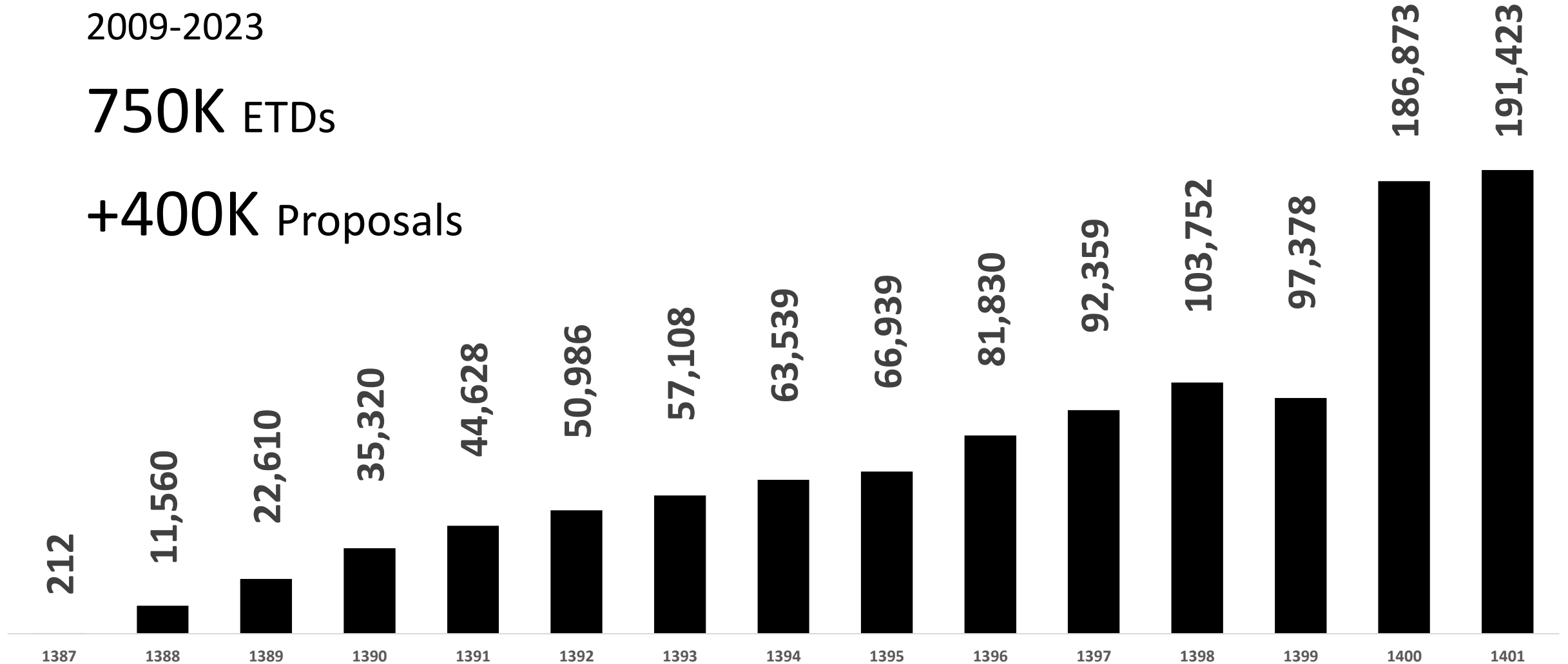

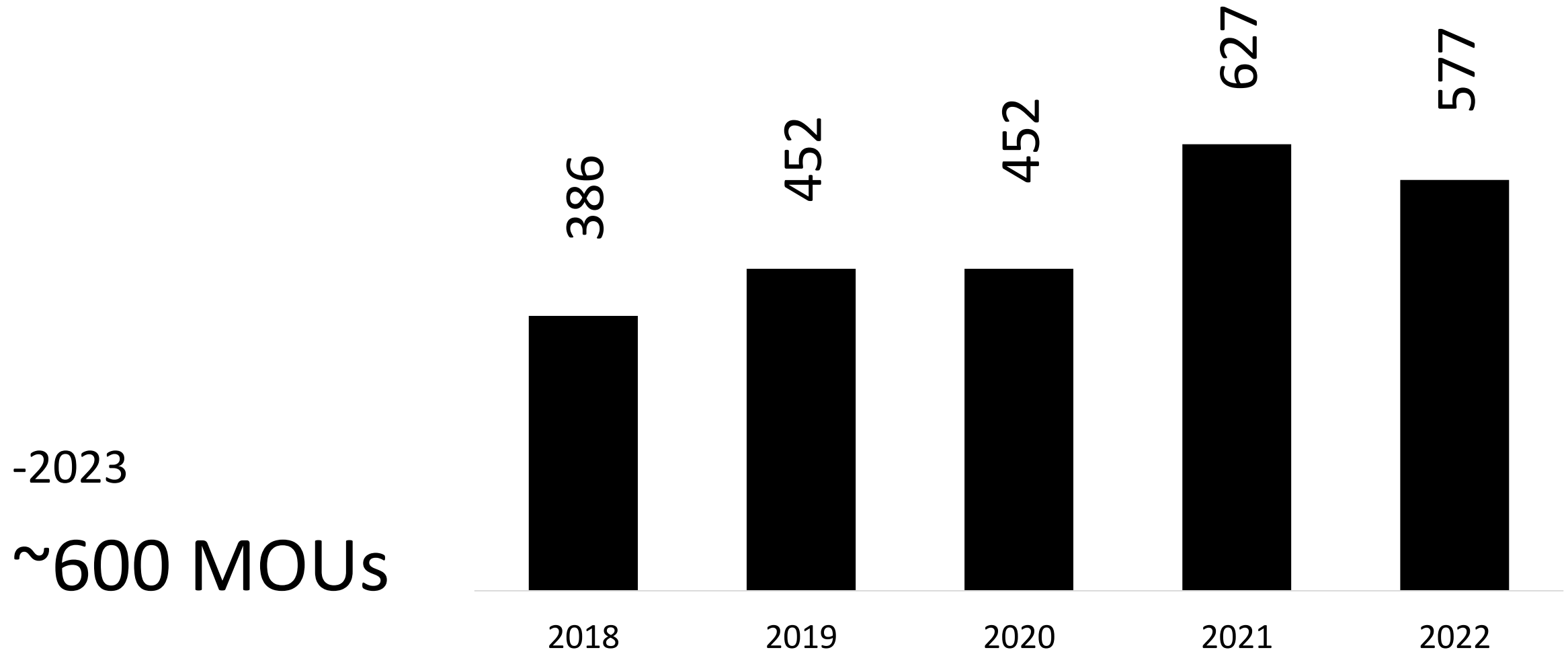

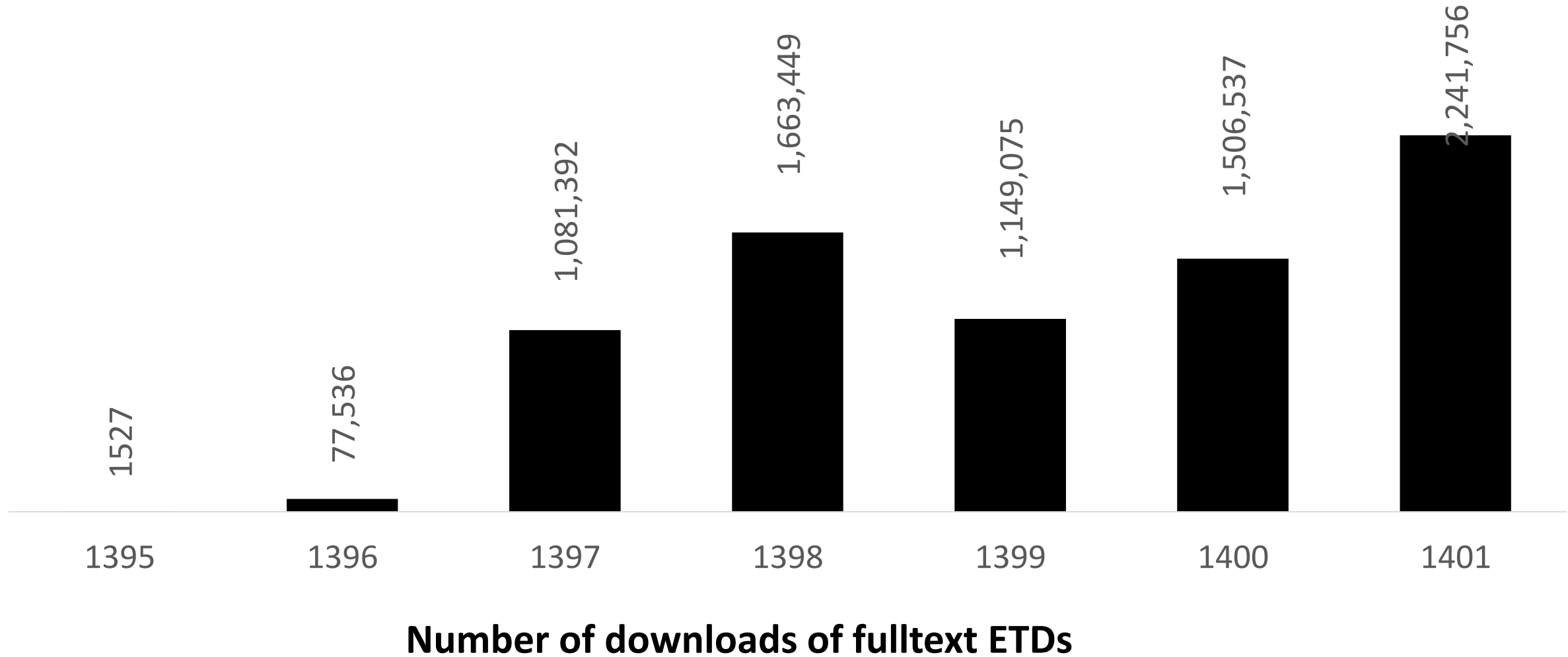

# Other Values

- ❑ Increasing productivity: accelerating access and networking;
- ❑ Academic responsibility: publishing public funded outputs;
- ❑ Monitoring research impact: citations, views, downloads, shares, ...;
- ❑ Employment Opportunities: hiring in academia and industry;
- ❑ Science policy: evidence-based policy making;
- ❑ Promoting equity: open access for ETDs at a nationwide level;
- ❑ Decreasing Financial Expenses: single infrastructure.

# Obstacles and Challenges

## Participation

Despite the enactment of parliamentary mandates, certain HEIs, particularly the larger ones are not participating in GANJ.



# Obstacles and Challenges

## Technological Infrastructure

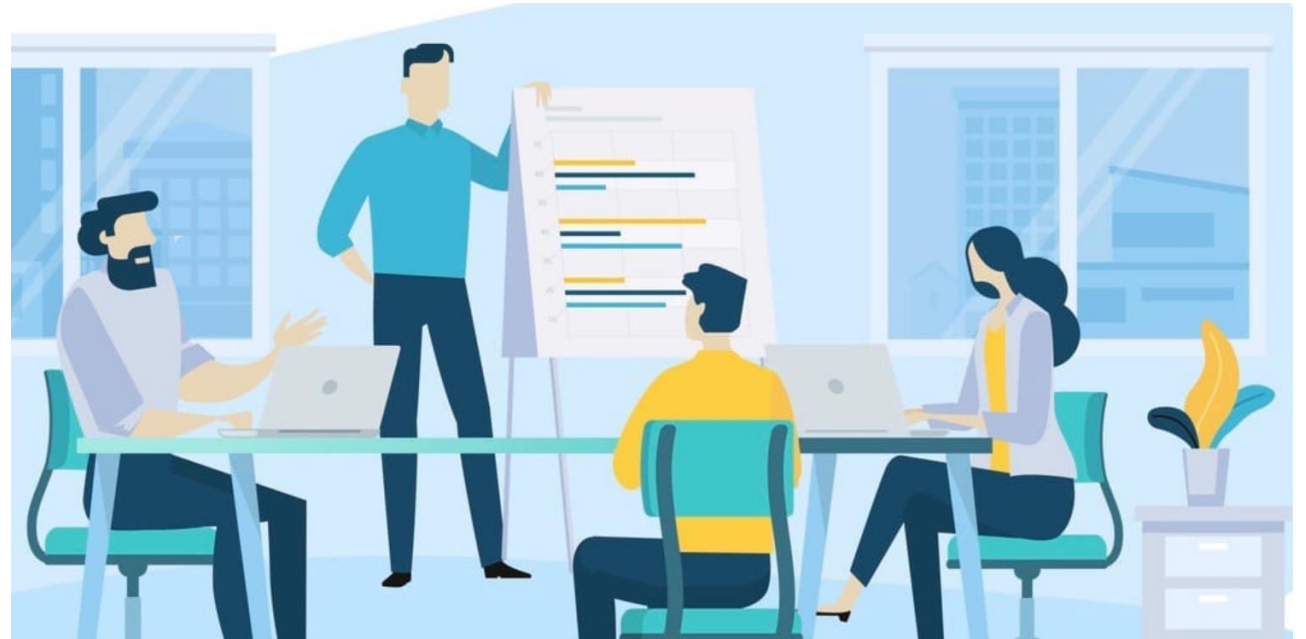
IranDoc bandwidth's limitations restrict users to downloading only five ETDs full-text per week, constraining broader access due to the traffic limitations.



# Obstacles and Challenges

## Human Resource

A considerable portion of submitted ETDs have been directly forwarded into 'Ganj', without the quality check.



# Obstacles and Challenges

## Intellectual Property Rights

Inadequate measures to safeguard against plagiarism in TDs pose a significant challenge, making it challenging for authors to initiate effective prosecution against potential plagiarists.



# Conclusion and Lessons Learned

- ❑ The information quality IS important;
- ❑ Thinking about a sustainable business model;

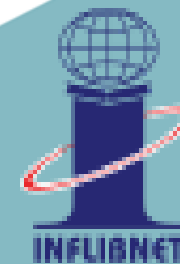
