This approach nurtures shared responsibility, collective decision-making, and respect for diverse perspectives. While it promotes collaboration, it may require careful structuring to ensure that individual growth and accountability are not compromised.

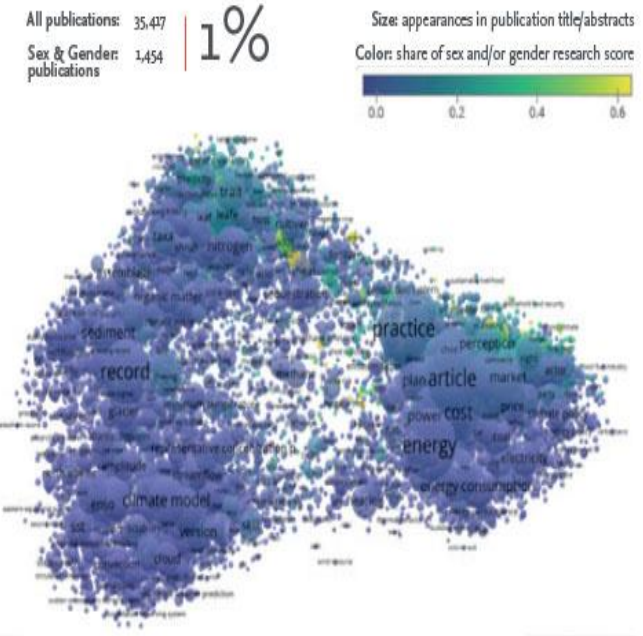
